- **Fee Schedule.** The fee schedule provides unlimited training plans. The tuition fee is based on our *family oriented philosophy*. The Individual rate is \$75/mo. and the Family Rate is \$125/mo and includes all immediate family members at the same address. Tuition checks should be made payable to **Pathways for Achievement** and are due on or before the 1st of the month.

As noted above the school is a not-for-profit business and all fees go to rent, utilities and other school expenses. Every black belt instructor is a volunteer who also contributes financially to the school. Although tuition is not tax deductible, additional donations to the school are always welcome and are tax deductible.

No student or family will be turned away for inability to pay training costs. Please speak to our office manager or one of the Instructors if you need financial assistance with the monthly tuition. Some scholarships are available.
